Always B Smiling Inc. is a Nonprofit Organization established in 2020 with the mission of creating smiles for children and families with disabilities and health challenges in the greater Pittsburgh area. Always B Smiling was founded by Dean and Kristin Huibregtse in honor of their son Bennett who passed away in July of 2020. Bennett had many struggles in life including 2 Kidney transplants, Cerebral Palsy, Cortical Vision Impairment, and Intellectual Disability. When Bennett passed, they made a promise they would continue to share his smile with the world and in doing so, bring smiles to so many others.

Bennett loved a good laugh while showing his amazing smile and that is the mission of Always B Smiling....to bring smiles to the ones who need it the most.

Always B Smiling offers support and experiences to an underserved population- children, teens and young adults living with disabilities and health challenges. Our goal is improving the mental, emotional, and social quality of life for the Pittsburgh's region's children, teens and young adults with disabilities and health challenges. We know when this goal is achieved because the smiles start happening.

Our vision is to operate a dedicated activity center that is open year-round, allowing children and their families a variety of social and educational opportunities in an inclusive, safe and welcoming environment.





ADAPTIVE BIKE RIDES AT A GLANCE

Children, teens and young adults with limited mobility enjoyed a family bike ride on the Montour Trail from the front seat of an adaptive bike, powered by a trained volunteer. We end the Bike ride with an ice cream social. This experience allows the participant, siblings, mom, and dad an opportunity to experience a family outing that they generally don't get the opportunity to experience. Being outdoors in nature brings an element of calmness, relaxation and freedom which leads to an improved mental state.

48 Bike Rides with 28 families and pedaled over 360 miles.

2021 SUPPORT SERVICES AT A GLANCE



Buddee Bags - while Children's Hospital provides extensive care for children, **Buddee Bags were** designed to bring smiles to the faces of kids facing longer stays. Bags included everything from headphones, plush blankets, stuffed animals and activity kits designed to bring comfort during their stay.

In collaboration with the Children's Hospital Nephrology department, Always B Smiling helped support the needs of families with children facing extended hospital stays or frequent hospital visits.

Over 65 bags of smiles along with \$6,000 granted to families with financial hardship.







COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AT A GLANCE

In our first year of operation, Always B Smiling had significant community engagement and partnered with several organizations that supported our mission. We sponsored two community blood drives addressing the urgent need for blood donations. We helped promote the need of kidney donation, asking for the community to be organ donors. Several schools in the area participated in fundraising, offering children with special needs a life skills program where they made and promoted Buddee biscuits, raising over \$500. Throughout the year we spread the word at universities, women's clubs, rotary clubs, state offices and affiliated nonprofits.

Always B Smiling and its mission of creating smiles became known in the community.



- Two fundraising events












2021 FUTURE VISION

Our future vision is to build and operate a dedicated activity center on the Montour Trail where Always B Smiling will enhance our existing programs and expand on them, including but not limited to operating a café that supports life skills for teens and young adults, a horticulture program, trail programs and seasonal activities that are not currently offered.

This center would be fully handicap-accessible and sensory-friendly and provide families the opportunity to gather in a safe, welcoming environment while enjoying the beauty offered on the trail and surrounding areas.

The population we serve has over 30,000 special needs children along with over 22,000 kids with medical challenges needing smiles.

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Support services to children, families and caregivers with long term health challenges at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh.

- Buddee Bags: Nephrology bags will help children and families during transplant or dialysis treatment to lessen the stress, help with mental health and create smiles.
- Buddee Bags: Expand to other units in the hospital.
 Directed Funds: Expand to other units in the hospital.
- Directed Funds: Work with Children's Hospital Nephrology Department to support a patients defined need such as travel, housing, hotel, food and lost income.

Address the many gaps that exist for children and families outside of traditional education programs.

CREATIVE PROGRAMS

- Adaptive Bike Rides: A program that offers free adaptive bike rides to those that may not be able to ride a bicycle on their own, a fun family day out on the Montour Trail ending with an ice cream social.
- Social Activities: Create an opportunity for children to socialize with their peers and community outside of school. Activities to include bowling, day at farm, craft day, pumpkin patch and teen night.
- Adaptive Bike Program: Expand to special needs schools offering a field trip where students can enjoy a bike ride and educational based activities.
- Social Activities: Horticulture, music therapy, OT/PT groups, kidney camp, transplant activities, and various seasonal themed programs throughout the year.

ACTIVITY CENTER

Always B Smiling will offer a life skills program for young adults with special needs. This will foster acceptance, inclusion, and pride while creating a deeper understanding and acceptance of diversity and inclusion in the community.

Activity Center

- Acquire land on the Montour Trail to operate the Always B Smiling Activity Center.
- Purchase dedicated structure to store bikes, and offer a safe place to socialize with peers.
- B Smilling Cafe: Operate a coffee shop/cafe where the employees will be ABS program participant. Our goal is to encourage life skill growth opportunities.
- Fundraising Program: The program will be designed for the ABS participants to execute a full step by step fundraising program from start to finish. The money raised will go back into the program.
- Assemble the Buddee Bags for the children at the hospital.
- Farmers Market: Sell items that the participants have grown in the horticulture program.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Community inclusion will offer program participants and peer volunteers to interact and learn from each other. This interaction will promote diversity and inclusion into the community.

- Buddy Program: A program offering participants and volunteers an opportunity to work together on projects and/or activities that utilizes assistance
 or support from a buddy.
- Volunteer program to support all our programs.
- Teachers and therapists will work collaboratively with ABS to design and implement curriculum that will optimize participants growth outside the traditional education setting.
- Collaborate with other local nonprofits with similar missions to make an even greater impact into the community.

- Miles for Smiles: Annual walk to raise funds and gain awareness. Collaborate with local businesses and nonprofits.
- Attend local nonprofit resource fairs.
- Present our mission to rotary clubs and chamber groups.
- Create and maintain business relationships to gain support of our programing in local communities.
- Grant writing and form relationships in the community.
- Partner with local private and public schools to form partnership with Always B Smiling.
